Disney Cruise Line Packing List

Documents

- Valid passports for everyone
- Cruise documentation including luggage tags
- Excursion documentation/confirmations
- Travel insurance documentation

Electronics

- Lanyards with sleeve or key cards
- Camera and lens (including waterproof case)
- Back-up camera batteries, charger, memory card, and power banks
- Smartphones and tablets
- Waterproof phone case or pouch
- eReaders or books
- Multi USB charger (plugs are limited in the staterooms and power strips are not permitted)

Daily Use Items

- Travel mug or cup (if you have your refill mug from the Disney resorts, that works perfectly!)
- Sun hats and goggles or sunglasses
- Face sun screen
- Day bag(s) or back pack (waterproof)
- String bag(s) for carrying stuff around the ship
- Watch (your phone won't always have the correct time)
- Autograph books (pillowcases or photo mats make great autograph keepsakes; make sure to bring an easy to use pen or marker for the characters)

For the Cabin

- Magnetic hooks
- Shoe organizer
- Magnetic Post-it notepad or dry erase board with velcroed marker (for leaving notes on door)
- Deck of cards and/or card games
- Laundry bag(s)
- Laundry detergent (if you plan to wash clothes)
- Ziplock or wet bags
- Wrinkle-release spray
- Fabric softener sheets (for suitcases)
- Gel or cling decorations for cabin door (to make it easy to find)
- Packing cubes/organizers

Toiletries & Medication

- Seasickness medication
- Cold medication
- Upset stomach medication
- Pain reliever
- Probiotics and vitamins
- Essential oils (such as lavender)
- Toothbrushes and toothpaste
- Moisturizer
- Lip balm
- Deodorant
- Hairbrush or comb
- Hair styling products and appliances
- Make-up and make-up remover
- Hair bands or pony-tail holders
- Hairbrush or comb

What should I wear?

At Sea Attire

- Casual shirts
- Pants/jeans/capris and shorts
- Sweater/light jacket
- Formal wear for Remy or Palo (men need to wear a jacket and dress pants/shoes; women should wear dresses, pantsuits, or a skirt/blouse; no jeans, shorts, capri pants, flip flops or sneakers)
- Rain Poncho
- Mickey Ears
- Socks
- Underwear
- Bathing suit(s)
- Bathing suit cover-up and flip flops
- Pajamas
- Casual shoes and sandals/flip flops
- Gym clothes and running shoes
- Water shoes

Pirate Night

- Pirate costumes
- Pirate eye patches and earrings
- Bandanas (they give you pirate bandanas in your stateroom)
- Temporary tatoos/face makeup
- Pirate t-shirt
- Pirate hooks (plastic or tin-foil)
- Pirate hat/wig
- Toy parrot

What NOT to Pack

- Irons**
While they are not available in-room, they can be found in laundry areas, or you can send your clothes out to be pressed for a reasonable rate.
- Shampoo and Conditioner**
Unless you have a specific brand, Disney provides their H2O Spa Collection as well as bar soap.
- Hair Dryers**
These are in-room; look in the desk drawer.
- Power Strips and Candles**
These are not allowed.
- Over-the-Door Organizers**
You will be charged for damage if you decide to use them. If it is something you can bring and hang in the closet, that is allowed.
- Lots of Cash or Valuables**
There are room safes, but most of your transactions will be done using your room card.
